2 Corinthians 5:17



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*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH (*unison*) Adapted from the Confession of 1967
We believe in Jesus Christ, the realization of true humanity. Jesus, a Palestinian Jew, lived among His own people, sharing their needs, temptations, joys, and sorrows. 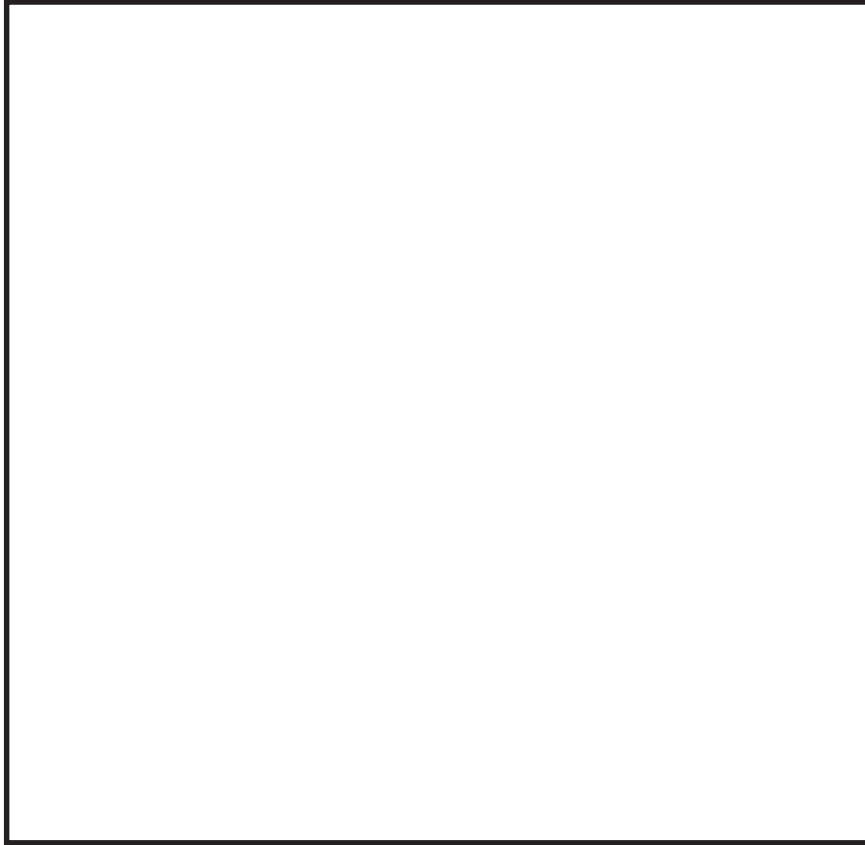
